The heavy snow last week went well with no major break downs; so far for this winter our salt use has been up approximately 50 tons mostly due to ice.

The break in snowfall has allowed us to work on other projects.

We have graded and added gravel to sections as they dry out on Silver Hill North and South sections, Burnell and North Woods roads.

We have removed been working on brush and trees on the Tooley Pond, Ritz, Boyd Pond, Hatch and Colton roads. We also have been cleaning up from the high winds on 3/6 and 28<sup>th</sup>.

We will be working with the county moving rock with the army trucks in Gouverneur.

Rodney informed me he wanted to return to work on April 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Our new truck is working well so we are able to strip the 01 international of its plow and sand equipment and use it for brush and trees.
