We have cut trees on the Forbes, Blackmer and Boyd Pond roads and cut brush back on the McCarthy road.

On the Ritz road we cut out the road and added to the base and re-graveled it. The road broke through this spring due to heavy equipment use.

We have graded and added gravel to all gravel roads as needed.

We have repaired the driveway and trimmed trees at the South Russell cemetery. I was wondering if the town could help out with the driveway there, maybe have it done with binder.

On the Burnell road we removed several trees, blasted 3 areas, widened shoulders, added gravel and replaced 3 pipe crossings and 1 driveway and installed 200 ft drainage tile.

We have installed drainage tile on Mill Street and Maiden Lane and added gravel through wet sections and built up the intersections with Pestle Street. We replaced 1 road crossing pipe and 3 driveways.

We will have our CHIP's projects ready well ahead on our scheduled paving. Maybe paving will occur the 2nd or 3rd week in June.

This has been a busy and very productive month and I thank the men for a job well done.

Dear Town Representative or Board Member,

We need to start scheduling the Sexual Harassment classes to maintain the town's compliance with the new state mandated changes to the New York State Sexual Harassment Law.

I recently completed the Train-the-Trainer seminar presented by NYMIR and would like to make everyone aware of some things I learned, before we start scheduling these classes.

First of all, anyone who works for the town in **any** capacity—this includes seasonal workers, part-time employees and unpaid volunteers—is **required** by New York State Law to complete this training.

Please be aware that Zachary Risk Management is only holding two Sexual Harassment seminars per town – one for the Highway Department and one for all other town workers. If you cannot make it to your assigned meeting, there will be no makeup class.

If an employee misses the class, a designated person from your town may proctor them taking the class online and sign off that they have completed the required course. Your town would then be required to maintain the records of

these trainings with proper dates and signatures. This training must be completed by October 9th 2019.

Finally, please be aware that this new regulation is very stringent and very thorough. The presentation itself is long—excluding any question and answers—and we are required to cover every part of the new regulation.
