- 1. Financial Report
- Details of all income and expense transactions have been filed with the Town Clerk.
- Account balances as of June 16, 2020, for the general fund, highway fund, capital improvement fund, and streetlight fund have been filed with the Town Clerk.
- With the ongoing pandemic I am still very concerned with our revenue situation. Between highway and general accounts, we are -\$199,862.19 at this time, and \$156,279.26 of this is sales tax. Things are starting to open up, which is a good sign. I am hoping by the end of July we will have a better picture of where we will stand as far as revenue.
- The Governor is allowing gatherings of up to 25 and I would like the boards opinion on opening up the town hall and ball field?
- Budget modification, I would like to decrease A1990.4 contingent by \$8,000 and increase A1910.4 unallocated insurance by \$8,000 for the payment for the auditors came out of the wrong account.

- 1. On a road commencing at 1 mile south of CR 24 (Blanchard Hill) and leading south a distance of approximately 6/10 miles there shall be expended not over the sum of \$43,785.34 type T6 width of traveled surface 18 feet thickness 1.5 inch
- 2. On the road commencing at approximately 1.5 miles north of CR 24 (Pyrites Russell road) and leading north a distance of 9/10 approximately miles there shall be expended not over the sum of \$36,543.32 type T6 width of surface 18 feet thickness 1 inch.
- 3. On the road commencing at 5/10 mile from road end (Boyd Pond Road) and leading to west a distance of 2/10 miles there shall be expended not over the sum of \$24,522.00 width of traveled surface 18 feet thickness 2.5 inch.
- 4. On the road commencing at CR 24 (Dana Hill Rd) and leading to 1 mile east a distance of 1 mile there shall be expended not over the sum of \$72,832.00 type T6, thickness 2 inch.
- 5. On a road commencing at CR 17 (Dana Hill road) and leading to west a distance of 3/10 miles there shall be expended not over the sum of \$28,438.00 type T6 width of traveled surface 18 feet thickness 2 inch.
- 6. On the road commencing at 1 mile east of Forbes road (Boyd Pond road) and leading to Boyd Pond East a distance of 1/10- miles there shall be expended not over the sum of \$23,248.00 type T3 and blasting width of traveled surface 18 feet thickness 2.5 inch for highway construction.
