SECTION 1. INTENT

Whereas the Town Board of the Town of Russell has determined that residents, and particularly land owners abutting the Town roads, have caused nuisance and potential danger to the Town by placing farm machinery, equipment and other debris in the road and/or within the Town's right-of-way thereby preventing Town employees from maintaining said roads and rights-of-way. The purpose of this local law is to protect the health, safety and well-being of persons and property within the Town by imposing restrictions as set forth below.

SECTION 2: ENACTMENT

Residents of the Town of Russell are hereby prohibited from placing any debris, including but not limited to, farm machinery, equipment, used or otherwise, hay bales, garbage and refuse on any road belonging to or maintained by the Town of Russell or St. Lawrence County, in said road or within the Town of Russell right-of-way consisting of 25 feet from the center of said Town road or 33 feet from the center of said County road.

SECTION 3: PENALTIES FOR OFFENSES

Any person convicted of a violation of this local law, in addition to any other civil or criminal penalty, shall be liable to a civil penalty of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the first violation, One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) for a second violation, and Two Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$275.00) for each subsequent violation.

This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.
